

# VETERAN SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT 2023-2

**<u>Purpose</u>**. To announce the semi-annual Veteran College Scholarship opportunity for Veterans and other eligible persons.

#### Information

**General.** The Southwest Veterans Foundation (SWVF) is the charitable arm of the Southwest Veterans Chamber of Commerce. The SWVF will award its next round of college scholarships to eligible Veterans (or eligible Veteran spouse/child) on or about November 11, 2023—Veterans Day. This scholarship may be used for tuition, books, classroom supplies, room and board, and other direct or indirect fees levied by the educational institution coincident to college enrollment and attendance. The announcement and application are combined into one document. A fillable pdf form is available on the SWVF.

Eligibility. There are three eligibility categories:

- Veterans with an Honorable Discharge
- Currently serving Military Reservists and National Guard (Active duty and "full-time" Reservists and National Guard are not eligible)
- Spouses and children of military personnel Killed in Action or 100% service disabled

## Proof of Eligibility

- Veterans. DD-214
- **<u>Reserve and National Guard</u>**. Proof of current Reserve or National Guard service and obligation.
- <u>Spouse or child of Veteran</u>. Proof of relationship to deceased or disabled Servicemember and proof of service death or 100% disability.

<u>Educational Verification</u>. Proof of current college attendance at an accredited college, community college, junior college, or post-high school technical institute.

#### <u>Timeline</u>

- Oct 4, 2023 Scholarship announcement released
- Nov 18, 2023 Applications due
- On/abt Dec 1, 2023 Scholarship winners announced.
- TBD: Scholarship presentations to the selectees

Please do not request an extension. Your ability to submit a <u>complete</u> application <u>on time</u> is an important part of the evaluation and grading of your application. Review these instructions before filling out your application.
